

CMP MILITARY RIFLE MATCH AT STILLWATER RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB ON JUNE 6, 2020

This is a CMP-sanctioned Military Rifle Match that follows the CMP Games Rifle and Pistol Competition Rules.

Date and Time: June 6, 2020 (Saturday). Firing starts at 9:00 a.m. You must arrive no later than 8:15 a.m.

Registration: Email the completed entry form to srpcsecretary@gmail.com. Maximum number of participants is 20. The first 20 email entries received will get to shoot. Bring your notarized Affidavit (if you haven't done it before) and entry fee to the match.

Location & Directions to the Range: Stillwater Rifle & Pistol Club is located on the west side of Lake McMurtry.

Eligibility: Anyone 12 years of age or older can participate. You do not need to be a member of the NRA, CMP or SR&PC. All competitors must have a notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file at the sponsoring club or present at registration. If your notarized form has already been filed at the club or CMP you do not need to submit it again. The form can be downloaded from thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Affidavit.pdf.

Entry Fee: \$8 for non-SRPC members, \$5 for SR&PC members, \$3 for Juniors (18 and under)

Rules: Current Edition of "CMP Games Rifle and Pistol Competition Rules" will be followed. It is available at no cost from thecmp.org/competitions/cmp-competitions-rulebooks.

Course of Fire: All shots are fired at SR-1 targets at 100 yards. Participants must provide their own ammunition (minimum 35 rounds).

- Stage 1 - Slow fire, prone, 5 sighting shots followed by 10 record shots, time limit of 15 minutes.
- Stage 2 - Rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 shots in 80 seconds.
- Stage 3 - Slow fire, standing, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

Rifles Permitted:

- As-Issued M1 Garand: In “as issued” configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights. Trigger pulls may not be less than 4.5 lbs.
- As-Issued Springfield M1903/1903A3: In “as issued” configuration firing caliber .30-06 ammunition and using original iron sights. Trigger pulls may not be less than 3.5 lbs.
- Other As-Issued U.S. Military Rifles: Permitted rifles are the Caliber .30 U.S. Model 1917 and the Caliber .30-40 U.S. Krag. Other U.S. military rifles such as the Caliber .30-40 M1895 (lever action) and 6mm caliber M1895 Lee-Navy rifle may be used. Trigger pulls may not be less than 3.5 lbs.
- As-Issued Foreign Military Rifles: Any non-US bolt action military rifle in “as issued” configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights. Trigger pulls may not be less than 3.5 lbs.
- Class A **Standard** U.S. Modern Military Rifles: Rifles based on the M-16 or AR design and manufactured by a USA manufacturer. Total rifle weight, with sights and without sling, may not exceed 7.5 lb. The rifle must be chambered for the 5.56x45 mm or .223 Remington cartridge. The trigger pull may not be less than 4.5 lbs. Only issue-type **metallic sights** are allowed.
- Class B **Standard** Modern Military Rifles: Modern military rifles manufactured in the U.S. or another country chambered for any cartridge not exceeding caliber 8 mm. Allowable rifles include AK 47, AK 74, SKS, FN-FAL, SVT, HK-91, HK-93, M-14, M1A, and FN-49. The trigger pull may not be less than 4.5 lbs. Only issue-type **metallic sights** are allowed.
- Class A and Class B **Unlimited** Modern Military Rifles: Same as Standard Rifles with these exceptions:
 - **Optical sights** (including reflective sights) with a power of **4.5** or less may be used. For variable scopes, the maximum power should not exceed 4.5. The objective lens diameter should not exceed 34 mm.
 - Rifle weights are unlimited.

Targets:

- SR-1 targets will be used.
- The bullseye (9-point ring) is 6.35 inches in diameter.
- The 10-point ring is 3.35 inches in diameter.
