

**PRECISION PISTOL MATCH
AT STILLWATER RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB
ON SEPTEMBER 26, 2020**

This is a club match, not sanctioned by the NRA.

Date and Time: September 26, 2020 (Saturday). Firing starts at 9:00 a.m. You must arrive no later than 8:15 a.m.

Registration: No registration is needed. But if you planning to shoot please let the club secretary know by writing to srpcsecretary@gmail.com.

Maximum number of participants is 24. The first 24 email entries received will get to shoot.

Location & Directions to the Range: Stillwater Rifle & Pistol Club is located on the west side of Lake McMurtry

Eligibility: Anyone 14 years of age or older can participate. You do not need to be a member of the club.

Entry Fee: \$8 for non-SRPC members, \$5 for SRPC members, \$3 for Juniors (18 and under)

Course of Fire: All shots are fired at 25 yards. Participants must provide their own ammunition (minimum 90 rounds).

- Stage 1 – Slow fire. 10 minutes per 10-shot string. Total 20 shots. Scoring after each 10 shots.
- Stage 2 – National Match Course, which consists of slow fire (10 shots), timed fire (10 shots), and rapid fire (10 shots). Total 30 shots. Scoring after each 10 shots.
- Stage 3 – Timed fire. 20 seconds per 5-shot string. Total 20 shots. Scoring after each 10 shots.
- Stage 4 – Rapid fire. 10 seconds per 5-shot string. Total 20 shots. Scoring after each 10 shots.

Shooting Position

- Option 1: Standing, one-handed. *You are recommended to choose this shooting position if you are planning to shoot NRA-sanctioned matches in the future.*
- Option 2: Standing, two-handed

Guns and Ammunition Permitted:

- Any handguns chambered for .22 LR, .45 ACP, or other handgun caliber between .22 and .45 are allowed. For revolvers, the barrel length including cylinder should not exceed 10 inches.
- Any sights are allowed (iron sights, red dot sights, etc.).
- Minimum trigger pull:
 - 3.5 lbs for .45 caliber semiauto handguns
 - 2.5 lbs for center-fire semiauto handguns with any caliber larger than .22 and less than .45
 - 2.5 lbs for center-fire revolvers regardless of caliber
 - 2.0 lbs for any type handguns chambered for .22 LR ammo (including semiauto and revolvers)

Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI):

- An empty chamber indicator is required to indicate that
 - the slide is open and the chamber is empty, or
 - the cylinder is out.

Targets:

- B-16 target will be used for 25-yard slow fire strings.
 - Bullseye (7-point ring) is 5.32 inches in diameter.
 - 10-point ring is 1.51 inches in diameter.
- B-8 targets will be used for 25-yard timed and rapid fire strings.
 - Bullseye (9-point ring) is 5.54 inches in diameter.
 - 10-point ring is 3.36 inches in diameter.
